Phil Wentz (Recipient for 2018-19) accepted the chair of the Education Committee in 2019 succeeding Keith Cooper as well as taking over teaching our Grounding class for Keith. He was also chair of the Consulting Engineers Forum from 2015 to 2019. Phil has served as co-chair on the Expo Seminar Committee which coordinates the 14 different seminars offered at an Expo and has already volunteered for this assignment at Electrical Expo 2023. He also assisted the Executive Committee and staff with the A/V requirements of our classroom when we moved to the 2nd floor during that year. Served on the EBMI Board of Directors since 2016,

Jan Olliges (Recipient for 2020-21) is an EBMI Volunteer that is seen helping the staff at many of our events. She has helped with the Christmas Mixer Jackpot since 1996 probably longer. 
JANUARY 18TH DEADLINE TO SUBMIT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS
