DUES INCREASE FOR 2023-24

The EBMI Board of Directors approved a 5% dues increase for the **2023-24 fiscal year** at their December 2022 Board meeting. Our last dues increase was in the 2018-19 fiscal year.

Treasurer Jeff Stoyanov explained that EBMI is no different than any other company that is seeing an increase in expenses.

A Corporate member paying \$365 will pay \$385 and members paying \$540 will move to \$570.


