Important information to Forward to YOUR Guests ...

(They can skim over items needed or find this info listed on our website as well.)

Many times, guests indicate to EBMI staff that they were not notified about parking, times, location and other important details. Since we cannot send to all guests, we ask each person making table reservations to forward this to YOUR guests to assist them BEFORE the Christmas Mixer as it makes your guests/customers' experience a lot more enjoyable. VERY IMPORTANT: Don't forget to remind them about our community projects..."Two Hands, Two Cans" and Salvation Army. (See Page 2 for details)

Parking for the Mixer – FREE PARKING AT ST. CHARLES CONVENTION CENTER. 1200 spaces. NO VALET.

As many of you know from attending the expos in the past, there is no charge to park at the St. Charles Convention Center (Exhibit hall entrance and parking is BEHIND the upper lot of SCCC and Embassy Suites. Go to the backside of the building for parking lot. You can drop off people carpooling with you at the front entrance and then go park. (Same entrance as used for the Expo attendees.)

DIRECTIONS

Going West into St. Charles: Take I-70 to Convention Center Blvd., Exit 229A. At stoplight, make a left turn and go over I-70. After the next stoplight, head into the roundabout left lane and go halfway around roundabout to the road alongside the St. Charles Convention Center. Parking lot is in BACK of Convention Center.

<u>Going East into St. Charles</u>: Take I-70 to Convention Center Blvd., Exit 229A. At stoplight, make a right turn and head into the roundabout left lane and go halfway around roundabout to the road alongside the St. Charles Convention Center. Parking lot is in BACK of Convention Center.

Coat check - 11:00 a.m - 2:30 p.m.(TO THE RIGHT OF THE ENTRANCE IN ROOM 104/105)

*Opens -11:00 a.m. - closes promptly at 2:30 p.m. so make sure to get your coats before this time.

*COAT CHECK SIGN will be located outside of the room. *EBMI is NOT responsible for items left in coat room.

EBMI Registration

*Please <u>DO NOT</u> stop at EBMI Registration table, unless you need to purchase tickets that day so the main entrance does not back up with guests arriving. <u>Registration table will NOT have any blank badges.</u>

BADGES ARE ATTACHED TO YOUR TICKETS. Badges are optional but most will use them and make sure to INCLUDE YOUR NAME AND COMPANY ON THEM.

*IMPORTANT: To save YOU time, please print your name AND company name on the badge BEFORE YOU ARRIVE and advise your quests to do the same. It's the blank badge to the left of each ticket.

*Table# is located on each ticket. If person in charge of table decides to keep all tickets, please make sure to let your guests know in advance your table#, so if they do not arrive on time, they can find you in Exhibit Hall.

*ONLY Board of Directors, Past Chairs of EBMI and Mixer Committee/Volunteers will have badges issued on table LOCATED to the LEFT of the exhibit hall entrance by Guest Service signs. <u>All others are responsible for printing their own badges</u>. Blank badges and markers will be provided in this area.

BAR AREAS:

*Hospitality Period – 11:00 a.m. – 12:05 p.m. In the Exhibit Pre-Function area (as you arrive, bars will be Iocated TO THE <u>RIGHT</u> IN LOBBY. IMPORTANT: Please do not stop upon first bar at entrance...plenty of other bars open if you head down to far right in the lobby. Less crowded and service will be much faster.

*ONLY WANT BEER, WINE OR SODA??? Save time and go to the Bars AT FAR END TO THE RIGHT – will have Beer/Wine/Soda purchase ONLY. This is only during the hospitality period. (So, if you only need beer, wine or soda, please move to these bars AT THE FAR RIGHT OF ENTRANCE to make the process simpler for you than at other bars. They will have standing signs in front of these 2 bars.) Mixed drinks, beer, wine, soda served at other bars as well.

- *Bars will allow for both Cash and Credit Cards. (You CANNOT RUN TABS. Must run credit card EACH TIME you place a drink order.)
- *Bars WILL CLOSE PROMPTLY from 12:05 p.m.-12:20 p.m. (Even if you are in line, they have instructions to shut down the bars so we can get everyone inside for lunch. Please make sure to get in line BEFORE 11:50 a.m. to have time before bars close to purchase drinks before luncheon.)
- *ONLY Two Bars will Reopen from 12:20 p.m.-2:45 p.m. They will REMAIN OPEN ONLY UNTIL 2:45 p.m. (After event, we encourage you to find another location if you wish to carry on your networking with industry associates, but will have these open for a short while after event.
