# The Lasting Legacy- Michael Postiglione

The Michael A. Postiglione Award is given out each year to a person who exemplifies Mike's motto in his time with our organization:

"Successful is the person who leaves the world better than they found it, who never fails to look for the best in others or gives the best of themselves."

Michael arrived in St. Louis from Yonkers, New York City in 1973 and started working at Bussman. Mike understood that the St. Louis Electrical Board (SLEB as were known at that time) was a way to make important industry connections. Mike gave of himself to the association. Along with the help of other industry professionals, they forever changed our organization.

Michael believed that one of the most important committees and where he wanted to contribute most was on the Education Committee. Beginning in 1978 this committee, made up of SLEB members, recognized the need for classes for our industry. They worked together to develop classes, which also generated revenue. Mike enjoyed being an instructor. These classes still continue today and are provided by EBMI.

Mike didn't' stop with the Education Committee and saw a bigger role in SLEB when he became an officer in 1984. He lent hs expertise as Chair on the following committees from 1984-2003: He was involved in ALL aspects of SLEB. Even with his various positions held at several consulting firms during this time Mike made time to give back to the industry. He became President of SLEB 1986-87.



Along this journey, Mike met his wife, Jackie through his involvement in the industry. Jackie served as Women's Electrical Board Chair in 1986-1987 and Jackie/Mike are the only husband/wife to both serve as EBMI Chair. Jackie served as EBMI Chair in 2001. In addition to involvement with SLEB, they were busy raising three sons. Michael began his own company, Avanti Technologies in 1986.

Mike passed away unexpectedly in January 2004. Friends and industry peers wanted to continue his legacy in assisting others. The *FAMILY and FRIENDS of MICHAEL A. POSTIGLIONE ENDOWMENT FUND* was established to provide Scholarships for children of EBMI members. A bowling event began in 2006 to raise funds. His family continues to contribute every year.


